T-Ball	Ages 4-6	\$125**	1st year players focused on fundamentals and skill development.	**\$25 Volunteer Fee added (per family) to registration and will be refunded after completion of two concession stand shifts.
Rookie (Coach Pitch)	Ages 5-7	\$125**	2nd year players. Hitting from a coach pitched ball	
Farm (Kid Pitch)	Ages 7-8	\$125**	Beginning competitive level with introduction to kid pitch (35 feet) Possible interleague play.	
Minors	Ages 8-11	\$125**	Competitive kid pitch (46 feet). Emphasis on advanced skills. Possible interleague play	** Additional \$25 fee for late registration after division evaluations.
Little League	Ages 10-12	\$125**	Players use more advanced skills to compete at a higher level. Interleague play.	
Intermediate (50/70)	Ages 12-13	\$125**	Players pitch from 50 feet and have 70 foot base paths	
Juniors	Ages 13-14	\$125**	Season might start in April if not in June after middle/ high school seasons end. Evals TBD	
Seniors	Ages 15-16	\$125**	Season starts in June after middle/ high school seasons end. Evals TBD

Frequently Asked Questions

What is included in the registration fee? Are there additional costs?

The fee includes a full uniform (hat, socks, jersey and pants), shared team equipment (bats, helmets, and catchers gear), umpire fees, opening day player lunch and end of the season family picnic. Players need to provide their own glove, rubber sole cleats and boys must have an athletic cup. If purchasing a bat, please see the USA baseball (not USSSA) standard stamp. Juniors/Seniors may wear metal cleats. BBCOR stamped bats are available to use in Intermediate (50/70) and Junior league. Seniors must use BBCOR bats. See Little League bat standards or email us with questions.

What is the schedule?

Practices begin April 1st. Practice days will vary to accommodate all teams. The game schedule will be created based on field availability and number teams per division. Players should plan on 1-2 games/practice during the week and 1 game/practice on Saturday. We do not play on Sundays. You will be notified of your pre-season practice schedule by March 31st. **Picture day is scheduled for April 23rd and Opening Day Parade is scheduled for April 30th.** A few weeks later you will receive the game schedule. Games begin the first week of May.

What are evaluations and should my child attend?

Evaluations are Sunday, March 20th at Livonia Athletic District (old YMCA building) in Livonia. Eval times will be available on rl3baseball.com and via email. All players are required to attend to have their skills evaluated. Coaches and league officials will be putting players through drills to assess their baseball skills and make recommendations on what division will be most appropriate. ALL players will be placed on a team regardless of experience. Farm through Senior divisions will use a draft method to select teams, therefore not all teammate/coach requests are able to be accommodated. No one is "cut" from the program. Junior/Senior evals TBD.

What are the residency requirements?

Players must live OR attend a school within our boundaries which include Redford Township, the City of Livonia as well as parts of Garden City, Westland, and Dearborn Heights. What is the refund policy?

Full refund (minus cost of uniforms if purchased) if the season is cancelled due to COVID-19.
 Half refund (also minus the cost of uniforms) will be given if less than six games are played and the season is cancelled due to COVID-19.
 NO REFUNDS will be issued after the start of the season for any other reason.
